



CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

Dear all,

We kindly invite you to the seminar titled “**Empirical data in linguistics: From research design to data analysis**”, which will take place **between 21 and 23 June 2017** at the Department of Translation, Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana.

At the seminar, we will address the central issues of research design in linguistics and introduce basic statistical methods for the analysis of language data. The seminar is primarily intended for young researchers (Master’s, PhDs and post-docs) in linguistics, language education and translation studies, but is also suitable for more experienced researchers who would like to refresh their knowledge of empirical approaches in linguistics.

The seminar will be organized in the framework of the national basic research project JANES (<http://nl.ijs.si/janes/>) and the international project ReLDI (<https://reldi.spur.uzh.ch>). The seminar is co-organized by the Slovenian research infrastructure for language resources and technology CLARIN.SI (<http://www.clarin.si>).

The attendance at the seminar is free of charge and we will organize free lunches, but participants need to cover their own travel and accommodation expenses. The number of participants is limited to 30 and **the selection will be on a first-come, first-served basis**. Depending on the expressed preference by the applicants, the seminar will be taught in English and/or Serbian.
